GUIDELINES

Young artists (ages 18 and under) are invited to submit up to five digital files via email to PBArtsInfo@copbfl.com. The Pompano Beach Cultural Affairs Department will be providing the printing for this exhibition at no cost to the young artists.

SUBMISSION

- There is no submission fee
- Up to five images per artists should be submitted in the following format:
 - JPG, 300dpi up to 10" on the long side
 - Name each file with your name and the title, for example: smith_jane_title.jpg
 - Deadline for Submission: November 1, 2019, before midnight.

Artists must submit high resolution JPEG files in their entry and the Cultural Affairs Department will print the selected images at exhibition quality for the exhibition at no cost to the artists. Artworks will be exhibited in high-quality 8" X 10" laminated prints and will possibly travel as a "travelling exhibition" to other locations in the community. At the close of the exhibition, photographers have the option to purchase the print for \$50 to cover the fees of printing, mounting, and backing. Artwork copyright remains with the artist at all times.
